*Relaxation of age limit is admissible as per rules in the case of candidates presently working in University/College service. SC/ST and OBC candidates are eligible for usual relaxation.*

- c) **Other conditions:** The appointments against the above vacancies will be made as per Mahatma Gandhi University Act 1985, Mahatma Gandhi University Statutes 1997, Mahatma Gandhi University Regulations, Kerala Service Rules and Kerala State & Subordinate Service Rules.

\* Re-notification as per U.O. No. Ad. A III/2/2006 dated 28.07.2006. In the absence of suitable SC candidates, ST candidates will also be considered.

## QUALIFICATIONS

### **1. Category A : Professor:**

An eminent scholar with published work of high quality, actively engaged in research, with 10 years of experience in Post Graduate teaching, and/experience in research at the University/National Level Institutions, including experience of guiding research at doctoral level.

**OR**

An outstanding scholar with established reputation who has made significant contribution to knowledge.

### **2. Category B: Reader :**

#### **Essential Qualifications:**

- (a) Good Academic record with Doctoral Degree or equivalent published work in the specialized subjects.
- (b) Candidates should also have at least 55% marks or, an equivalent grade of B in the 7 point scale with latter grades O, A, B, C, D, E and F at Master's Degree level.
- (c) 5 years experience of teaching and/or research excluding the period spent for obtaining the research degrees.

### **3. Category C: Lecturer**

#### **Essential Qualifications:**

Good academic record with at least 55% marks or, an equivalent grade of B in the 7 point scale with latter grades O,A,B,C,D,E and F at Master's Degree level in the relevant subject from an Indian University, or, an equivalent degree from a Foreign University. Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, candidates should have cleared the eligibility test (NET) for Lectures conducted by UGC, CSIR or similar test accredited by the UGC. However, the candidates having Ph.D degree in the concerned subject are exempted from NET.
